Boston is America's premier college town and one of its most international cities; it's also one of the nation's oldest, first incorporated in 1630. Our Boston program is offered on the campuses of **Tufts University** and of **Northeastern University**. Tufts is located on a beautiful 150-acre campus in the Medford/Somerville area of Massachusetts, only 5 miles from downtown Boston. It offers the best of both worlds: a safe, suburban campus and fast public transportation access to Boston, the largest college town in the country. Our accommodations at **Tufts** are in suite style air conditioned units with living room, kitchen, single and double rooms and semi-private bathrooms with in the unit. **Northeastern University** is located in the heart of in a neighborhood known as the Fenway Cultural District, near Back Bay, the Museum of Fine Arts and Symphony Hall. The 73-acre campus is dynamic, modern and welcoming. **Northeastern** offers single and double accommodations in air conditioned suite style units or apartments with semi-private bathrooms.
